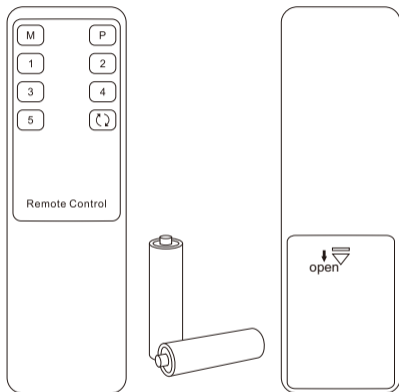

HDMI KVM Switch can easily integrate cross-platform computer devices and greatly simplify the devices management. 2x1/4x1 HDMI KVM Switch can control 2~4 PCs with only 1 HDMI display.

This KVM support USB 3.0 ports with superspeed data transfer rate. With 1 USB-A charge port on the front panel, support BC 1.2 protocol to charge devices like mobile phones and tablets. This product also supports several other switching modes. You can switch input ports with front panel button, IR signals, keyboard hot keys and mouse gestures (fast switching mode). At the same time, with EDID emulators in each input port, it can keep PCs always having correct display information.

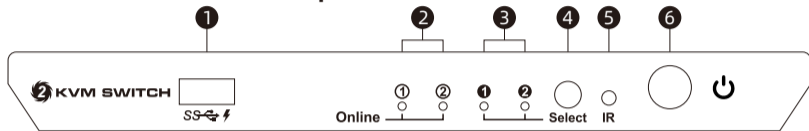

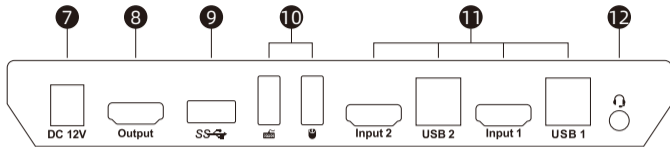

7.1 2x1 KVM Switch Panel Description

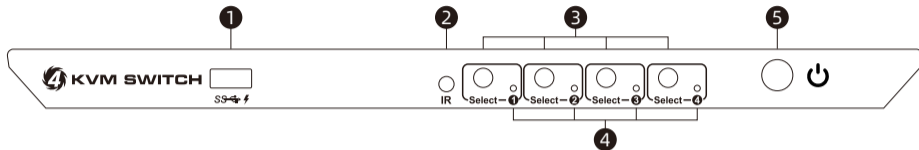

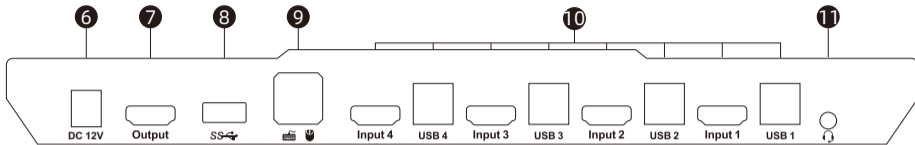

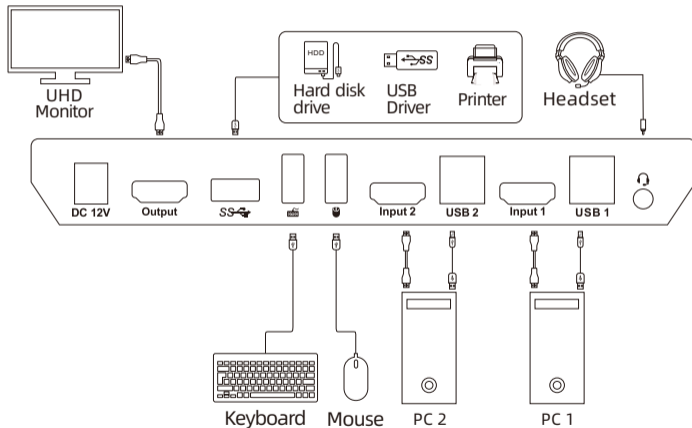

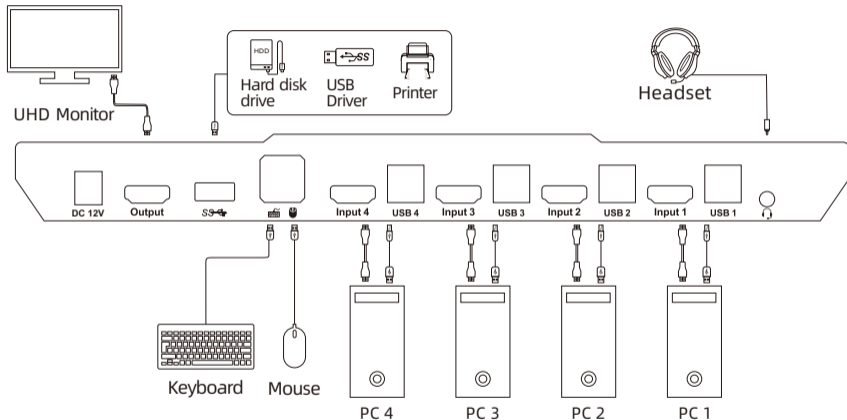

8.1 Connection Diagram-2x1 KVM Switch



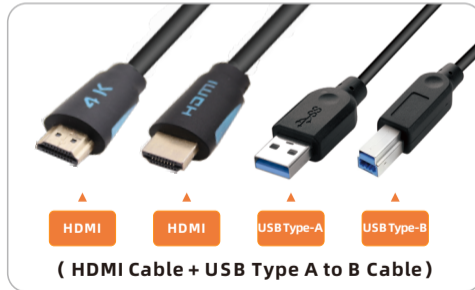
8.2 Connection Diagram-4x1 KVM Switch



Tips: For your better use of this product, we suggest you connect each group port on the KVM to the same PC.

8.3 Connection Preparation

- Take into consideration all devices required to be connected and prepare a workbench large enough before the connection.
- Lay out the cables properly to facilitate the layout of power supply as a lot of power sockets and plug boards will be adopted in connection.
- Prepare different sticker labels to mark cables as a lot of cables will be adopted in connection.



8.4 Connection Steps

Here we take 4x1 KVM Switch as an example to demonstrate the connect steps. The 2x1 KVM Switch is as the same steps to connect.

1. Connect PC1 with 1 KVM cable, use HDMI end to connect PC1 to the HDMI port on the KVM, use USB Type-A end to connect PC1 and Type-B end to connect the KVM.



2. Connect PC 2~4 with the same method.

3. Connect external mouse and keyboard to KVM's keyboard and mouse input port.



Tips: For the normal service of hotkeys, we recommend you use the full-key external keyboard with a separate **[Scroll Lock]** key (as shown above).

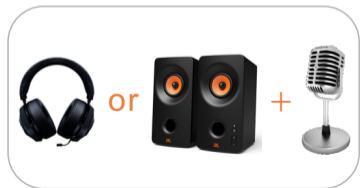
4. Connect USB 3.0 devices to KVM's standard USB 3.0 port.



5. Connect KVM's HDMI output ports to 2 HDMI displays with 2 HDMI cables.



6. Connect external audio device to KVM's L/R out port.



7. Connect the power cable to KVM's DC 12V port and plug it to a power socket.



8. By now, the connection has been completed. Turn on the power supply and the KVM Switch will begin to work.

Tips: Please refer to Page 20 for how to use the front panel charging port.

9. Function Description

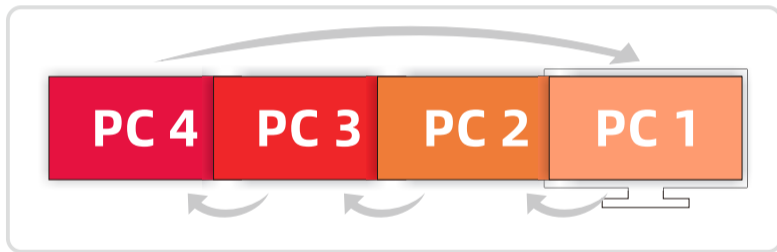
9.1 Built-in Charging Module

The HDMI KVM Switch has built-in charging module which can charge your phone, tablet and other devices. Use the USB-A port on the front panel of the KVM can support data transmission while charging. The USB-A port support BC 1.2 protocol, and is able to match voltage and current automatically based on the specifications of charging devices. It makes your charging safe and avoid damage.



9.2 Auto Scan Mode

Auto Scan can automatically switch the display at regular intervals between the input devices that are powered on and connected to the KVM. As a result, any input devices connected to each port can be monitored without user intervention. Auto scan mode is off by default.



- Tips:**
1. The 2x1 HDMI KVM Switch will automatically switch between PC 1 and 2 after enable auto scan mode.
 2. Please refer to Chapter 10 for detailed information about how to set the auto scan mode.

9.3 Mouse Wheel Switching

Mouse wheel switching method can quickly switch input sources by mouse operation, double-click the mouse wheel to switch to the next input port. Mouse wheel switching mode is off by default. You can use keyboard hotkey command [Right-Ctrl] + [Right-Ctrl] + [F6] to turn on mouse wheel switching mode.

10. Operation Method

10.1 Front Panel Button Switching Method

The 2x1/4x1 HDMI KVM Switch can switch to any input devices at any time with front panel keypad, IR remote control, keyboard hot keys and mouse wheel switch mode. You can choose your favorite switching method according to your personal needs and habits.

- **2x1 KVM Switch front panel**
 - Switch the input devices by pressing the button **[Select]** on the front panel of the KVM Switch. For example, press **[Select]** until you see the ② LED is lit. That means you have selected PC2 as input.

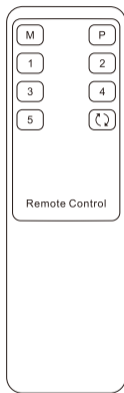


Tips: The 'Online' LEDs will be lit if the USB ports on KVM are well connected to and recognized by PC. 'Select' LEDs indicate the current selected computer.

- 4x1 KVM Switch front panel
- Switch the input devices by pressing those **[Select]** buttons on the front panel of the KVM Switch. Press the button **[Select]** corresponding to the identification of each PC to switch to the desired PC. The indicators will be lit to indicate which PC is currently displayed.



10.2 IR Remote Control



- ① — Switch to PC 1
- ② — Switch to PC 2
- ③ — Switch to PC 3
- ④ — Switch to PC 4

Tips: 1. Unspecified buttons at above are non-functional.
2. The buttons ③ and ④ are only works on 4x1 KVM Switch.

10.3 Keyboard Hot Keys

→ Use external keyboard hot keys to switch the input source or set up some other functions..

Tips: The keyboard hot keys can only work with external keyboard correctly connected to the keyboard and mouse input port of the KVM.

After press **[Right-Ctrl]** key twice within 2 seconds then please enter the commands within 3 seconds and the KVM will execute the corresponding commands.

Select previous input port:

[Right-Ctrl]→[Right-Ctrl]→[PgUp]



Select next input port:

[Right-Ctrl]→[Right-Ctrl]→[PgDn]



Select port by port number(For 2x1 KVM Switch):

[Right-Ctrl]→[Right-Ctrl]→[1]~[2]



Select port by port number(For 4x1 KVM Switch):

[Right-Ctrl]→[Right-Ctrl]→[1]~[4]



The following hot-key commands do work for both 2x1 KVM Switch and 4x1 KVM Switch:

Disable or enable buzzer sound:

[Right-Ctrl] → [Right-Ctrl] → [F11]



Tips: The default setting of buzzer sound is enabled. Repeat this step to disable or enable buzzer sound.

Turn on or off mouse gesture mode:

[Right-Ctrl] → [Right-Ctrl] → [F12]



Turn on/off mouse wheel switching mode:

[Right-Ctrl] → [Right-Ctrl] → [F6]



Turn on auto scan mode:

[Right-Ctrl] → [Right-Ctrl] → [Space]



Tips: The default auto scan time interval is 5 seconds. You can change the time interval by the front panel buttons or following the step presented below.

Increase or decrease auto scan time interval:

[Right-Ctrl] → [Right-Ctrl] → [+] / [-]



Tips: This hot key command can only work while the auto scan mode is activated. Press [Right-Ctrl] twice and keep pressing [+] / [-] key to adjust the time interval continuously. Increase or decrease 1 second at one time.

Press [Esc] to exit auto scan mode.



11. Change Hot Key Combinations

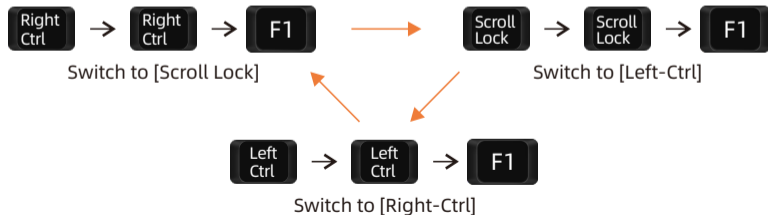
There are three kinds of trigger hot keys in this product, the default is **[Right-Ctrl]** key, and the alternative are the **[Scroll Lock]** and **[Left-Ctrl]** key. You can switch the hot key to others by:

Method 1:

- 10 seconds after powering on the KVM, press and keep holding the **[Select]** button on the front panel until you hear the buzzer is beeping, the control hot key are switched.

Method 2:

- Press keyboard hot keys to cyclically switch the control hot key.



12. Pass Through Mode Description

12.1 Introduction of Pass through mode

Pass through mode is a built-in function of KVM, which is able to improve keyboard and mouse compatibility and enhance user experience. In the pass through mode, the keyboard and mouse are equivalent to directly connecting to the computer. At this time, you can use more keyboard and mouse functions and special functions that are not supported by traditional KVM.

Tips: The current version does not support keyboard and mouse connection via Bluetooth.
